I agree. What I was trying to stress with the "eyecandy" are not icons or themes (they look fine); I think the browsers lack some ordering. I mean, yes except for the class browser they don't necessarily have to be in treeviews. But you (or in time, after I master the source code of theIDE maybe "we") could improve the browser listviews. Imho, they are confusing. For example, why not adding header controls and columns (which may indicate or hold some additional details of the listed items)? I mean, they don't even have any titles.

These little details could be important for newcomers.
