I made a mistake, the source code of linux drivers can be found along with the kernel sources, but the link I gave you works as well.

Anyway I joined a zip file with some example drivers including the one I modified which is as simple as it can get.

In order to be able to compile the drivers you must have the xorg headers installed. Usually the 'dev' packages contain it.  
Install it by using something like yum (on fedora).

You have every thing you need now.  
Links, example sources, headers, and build scripts.
