Hi gabor,
It's not a bug, it's a feature PromptOK (and many other controls in U++) allows to use formatted text in QTF format. In this format a lot of characters including + and - have some special meaning. If you want to type just ++ or -- you have to escape them by apostrophe: PromptOK("Ultimate'++"); or escape whole group of characters using byte 1: PromptOK("\1whatever--\1");
For more information about QTF see it's manual.
