But now the problem is that second application should "send" to first one it's command line, so if I doubleclick a file it'll open on the first running instance.

Example, file a.myapp and b.myapp

I doubleclick on a.myapp, the application opens and loads a.myapp file

then I doubleclick on b.myapp, the app start, discovers that another instance is running, "sends" its command line to the running instance and leave, so running instance can open the second file. I can do on Linux, but I'd like a portable way....
