Hi Ion,

Chromium uses the same WebCore as WebKitGTK+ (which is what libwebkit should be properly called). There is also more ports e.g. Qt, clutter, wx (under construction). The reason why I started with GTK version was that it seems to be available on many systems and that U++ already uses gtk (for chameleon). Also there is many simple examples for gtk version, but I couldn't find one that would show how to work with the chromium port.

Only difference I know about is that chromium port is tweaked towards usage in separate processes.

Technically it should be about the same amount of work to get chromium, Qt or gtk to work in U++...
