Got it to run once.

Now I get this error:  
LINK : fatal error LNK1181: cannot open input file  
'C:\upp\out\MyApps\Web\MSC9.Force\_Size.Gui.Mt\Web.lib'

This is my code:

}

```

C:\upp\out\MyApps\Web\MSC9.Force\_Size.Gui.Mt is empty.  
The same for MSC10 and debug

The first time it compiled and ran it put the .exe in:  
C:\upp\out\MyApps\MSC9.Debug.Debug\_Full.Gui.Mt\NLNe.exe  
and that seems to run OK.

Why the Web directory?  
I have a java app that has a server to connect with.

edit: Even with a reboot and upp re-install it gives the same error:
