Hello friends,

I had installed Ubuntu hardy Heron 8.04 on my laptop using Wubi to compile some server.c and client.c projects for my socket programming project on Linux OS. I was able to view the desired results with the following commands. It's only that when I re-installed Ubuntu and MySQL client-server, I'm getting the following gcc compiler errors that I didn't get before. Please help me out.

```
gcc: server: No such file or directory
```

```
server.c:13:19: error: mysql.h: No such file or directory
```

```
server.c:47: error: (Each undeclared identifier is reported only once  
server.c:47: error: for each function it appears in.)
```

Please note that I've already run the command "sudo apt-get build-essential"
The above command to compile mysql server worked like a breeze before but now it's giving me the above errors. I'm really concerned about the gcc errors as remaining errors depend on that. Please help me out guys. Thanks.
