There appears to be an issue with GridCtrl related to child ctrls the selected row and focus in general.

How to replicate:

```
class myapp : public TopWindow {  
    GridCtrl gridctrl;
```

    myapp() {  
        Add( gridctrl.SizePos() );  
        gridctrl.AddIndex("thing_id");  
        gridctrl.AddColumn("check","Check").Ctrls<Option>().Default(0);  
        gridctrl.AddColumn("name","name");  
  
        gridctrl.Add(0,0,"me");  
        gridctrl.Add(1,0,"you");  
        gridctrl.Add(2,0,"them");  
        gridctrl.Add(3,0,"him");  
    }  
  
}
```

Compile the app.

a) Enter the GridCtrl, press the <space>, then <tab> twice, then <space>.

b) using the arrow keys, move up and down across all of the rows.

The result:

a) The cell two above's checkbox will uncheck.

b) as the cursor moves the box which are selected will change.

I am guessing something is not properly refreshing when WhenCtrls Action is called.
