Suppose, I have a CSV table like this: A,B,C 1,2,3 4,5,6 Reading it line-by-line is no problem. E.g. I can store each line as a String or (already decomposed) in a Vector<String> or Vector<Value>. Once I read the table from the file I'm interested in the columns. E.g. I'd like to get column C for further manipulation: C, 3, 6 Suppose I changed it into somethig different, like: D,100,200 I want to assemble a new table for storage, e.g. D,B,C 100,2,3

I'm not aware that there is something ready-to-use for this purpose, besides ArrayCtrl, may be.
