img.SetImage(CtrlImg::exclamation());  
Add(img.SizePos());
```

```
EditField::Style edit_field_style = EditField::StyleDefault();  
edit_field_style.paper = Yellow();  
myedit.SetStyle(edit_field_style);
```

To set ALL edit field styles:

```
EditField::Style edit_field_style = EditField::StyleDefault();  
edit_field_style.paper = Yellow();  
EditField::StyleDefault().Write() = edit_field_style;
```
