A macro like this doesn't work in theide :

```
macro "Salute" Ctrl+Alt+S {  
    .Execute("echo Ciao")  
}
```

You get only a MacroExecute: echo Ciao in the console, and nothing tells you the command actually didn't get executed.

To get things working it is necessary to call cmd, so this works

```
macro "Salute" Ctrl+Alt+S {  
    .Execute("cmd /C \"echo Ciao\" ")  
}
```

This isn't very intuitive...
