Becuase certain actions can cause lots of display refreshes (like dragging a window) I would like to maintain a buffer to reduce CPU load between refreshes:

}
buffer.Put(w, 0, 0);
```

buffer is a BackDraw object (I was going to use ImageDraw before I saw BackDraw). This seems to work OK, but is this the way to do it?
