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I have revised the code:

```
Vector<String> v2;
```

```
v2.Add("Str1");  
v2.Add("Str2");  
v2.Add("Str3");
```

```
for (Vector<String>::Iterator b = v2.Begin(), e = v2.End(); b != e; b++)  
{  
    std::cout << "member " << " : " << *b << std::endl;  
}
```

Compiles OK, but i have this strange output:

```
member : 0x80cafb0  
member : 0x80cafb4  
member : 0x80cafb8
```

Not, Str1, Str2, Str3 as expected.

UPDATED:

and now it behave strange. I compile it second time and many errors are produced. I am using Slackware 11, with GCC version 3.4.6.
