Thank you for the answer

I'd already found the FindIndex algorithm, it works good for me.

The GetIndex of array class is really a danger, I lost 2 ours before understanding it works only on pointer value.

It's right, it's not documented, but I was thinking was a doc problem

I know that FindIndex does linear search, but I don't need speed (for now, at least), I'm making a quick and dirty console app to package OpenCascade libraries in Thelde format, separating packages and so on.... as the original version as an all-in-one include dir with 15000 files inside, it's hard to do it by hand.

I think it would not be a bad idea to have a 'real' FindIndex function in array class, it's often needed and it would be nice to have it without need of external algorithm.

A little note (again) on help system : I find it really unusable. That's the only thing I don't like on TheIde. I'm resorting with some fiferox windows opened by side, but I'm really missing a word search also on custom help files from the ide, as it has been done on codeblocks, for example.
