But are there any "rectangle" methods that doesn't exclude them? I hate to take care of nc area manually all the time

Well, the important reason for this is that in X11, there is generally not possible to use reactangle with decorations. X11 only allows you to work with the "client" rectangle. That is why all such methods were carefully removed from U++ so that we are X11 compatible....

I am afraid you will have to find a way not using AdjustRect if you want this to work in Linux.
