I made it with:

```
ProgressIndicator::Style style; // in main class declaration
```

```
style.hlook = CtrlImg::PI();
```

```
style.hchunk = CtrlImg::PIC();
```

```
style.vlook = CtrlImg::VPI();
```

```
style.vchunk = Images::VPICblue();
```

```
Prog1.SetStyle(style);
```
