Thanks. The reason I'm interested is that I'm still working on a version of this myself (for fun as much as anything else). I've attached a demo, which is pretty much feature complete barring the X11 port. I've decided that your drag-drop approach is better than VS style popups, but it's not quite as pretty as yours

Known issues:

Autohide popup alignment is incorrect on right/bottom bars (I have no idea why this is, it varies depending on the window).

Sizing of docked windows isn't intelligent enough yet.

Tabs are quite ugly (I'm waiting for the new Chameleonized QuickTabs so I can steal the drawing code).

Still not tested on Vista, so please let me know if there are problems.
