Thanks. There are three things I need:

1) The system the application is a front-end for uses an integer date type that is different from the  
Upp Date int type. For convenience it is easiest to have a custom Convert that can accept this  
type. Obviously there is no point adding this.

2) I do some key handling so that the user doesn't have to type the date separators themselves,  
so they can just type 020807 and have 02.08.07 in the field. I guess this could be added as an  
option and based on GetDateFormat, but would anyone else want it?

3) I want NullText set for every date field, and it's easiest to do this in the constructor.

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
