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At least on Linux, there is another issue - widely used fonts (e.g. Bitstream Vera) do not contain required unicode characters. Other toolkits hide this fact by picking required characters from other fonts. We will fix this issue asap (probably by synthetising missing chars).

Of course, if this is the case, you would see "boxes" instead of characters. If this is not true, we will do further investigations...
