I ended up focusing mainly on the drag-drop approach since nobody said they wanted it done this way, and when I had to rewrite it to add X11 support (that was a complete bitch!) I didn't bother with it. It was quick to add it back and I'd always planned on having different interfaces - in fact I've got a couple of less orthodox ones I'll try out once I've fixed some other things.

Quote: I hope it makes it into CtrlLib or some other "official" package. But I also like Oblivion's docker. He's looks a little better (even though the tabs could be smaller), but your's behaves a little bit nicer.

The code comes in the bazaar section of the SVN, and I hope that once it's more polished it will be added to the officially numbered distributions (probably as a separate package like GridCtrl), but that's up to the U++ team.

Appearance-wise you could make it look identical to Oblivion's version (apart from the Tabs) just by changing the fontsize and handle images in the DockableCtrl Cham. style, and eventually I'll have to have more styles available. I personally quite like it with the much smaller handles.
