What did I do wrong??

Hard to say. Looks like you do not have icon.ico file in your package directory and that you do not have app declared inside GUI\_APP\_MAIN....

Maybe I was not clear enough, in your code should be something like

```
struct MyApp : TopWindow {....
```

```
// or perhaps : WithMyLayout<TopWindow>
```

```

```

```
GUI_APP_MAIN {
    MyApp app;
    app.Icon(Image::Icon(5555, true), Image::Icon(5555, false));
    app.Run();
}
```
