Well, there is the obvious way

```
arrayCtrl.AddColumn();
arrayCtrl.AddColumn().Ctrls<Option>();
arrayCtrl.Add("Option 1", true);
arrayCtrl.Add("Option 2", true);
arrayCtrl.Add("Option 3", false);
```

But if you want to make things difficult for yourself:

```
// Members
ArrayCtrl array;
Array<Option> options;
```

...

```
array.AddColumn("Options");
array.Add(true);
array.Add(true);
array.Add(false);
```

```
array.SetCtrl(0, 0, options.Create<Option>().SetLabel("Option 1"), true);
array.SetCtrl(1, 0, options.Create<Option>().SetLabel("Option 2"), true);
array.SetCtrl(2, 0, options.Create<Option>().SetLabel("Option 3"), true);
I believe there are also others (you could use a factory for instance).
```
