How and when is it calculated ? ( 3968 / 72 != 8,5 )

When U++ is dealing with "physical units" (like the real world distances on paper media), it always uses "dots". 1 dot is defined as 1/600 inch (and is equal to single pixel on 600dpi printer).

All other units are converted to (and from) dots.
