I found some trouble with internationalization.
Tr file contain only system messages, and NOT contain any standards string, are needed to quick translation.

*.tr files are for running time translation. If you want your app to get translated and translation included in executable you must us a *.t file. it works for me very well.

Yes. I see.

But t-file is synchronized from IDE .tr files.

Nope, that is not correct. Normally, .t file us "syncned" (updated) based on source files in the package.

.tr files are used to provide "wholesome" translations, like translating the whole U++, by 3rd party. Anyway, as developer, you are supposed to use .t to translate your application.
