I'm here too, I just don't care about localization of applications (actually I hate them, I always prefer English version of SW as localized SW tends to produce all kind of subtle (but time consuming) problems to me, like not understanding GUI - some translations are weird and don't capture the original English meaning very well, problems with different decimal separator (total hell for any scripts and parsers which are not prepared for that), etc...).

That does not mean your translation is not welcome even by me, it may be handy one day. If applications can switch between languages easily, it's ok for me, I just hate that SW which does use even different binary for every localization and can't be switched in menu.

BTW, after writing this I ran TheIDE to try some translation just out of curiosity... and guess what ... I don't see how to switch it to other than English language in menu.
