knowledge) that Print method of the RichEdit must be virtual, what do all of you think? And it must receive the printer job handler, right? Thus, if someone wants to print something external to the RichEdit control he or she could rewrite the print method and print what he wants in conjunction with the contents of the RichEditControl. I have tried this but code is very complex and confusing I

difficult for me to make this virtual and supply the printer context already initialized. Anyone with a better solution?

My test case is this: I have a dialog with some 2 sets of edit boxes and a RichEditWithToolbar. The user write a letter in the RichEditWithToolbar and the first set of edit boxes are the source address and the second set of edit box is used to fill the target address. Both addresses and letter must be printed in the same paper sheet at specific location in order to position the target address in a transparent plastic window of the envelop.
