The last line of main is now:

```
delete G_STATE;
```

G\_STATE is a macro so, it's equal to:

```
delete globalState::getInst();
```

since getInst returns a pointer, it's all ok.

Well, well, that is the price of NOT using U++ way of programming:)

We have nice Single template.

Remove these statics and just use `Single<GlobalState>()` instead of `GlobalState::getInst`. Also, your version is MT broken (depends on compiler); Single is guaranteed to work.

No well-behaved program should contain similar "delete"
