Oblivion, I think you should abandon DockCtrl DEV802b.2 and just move out DockCtrl and DockCtrlExample to the root (like before).

For example I used svn root directory in upp assembly definition and I'm not able to run DockCtrlExample app because it has `#include <DockCtrl/DockCtrl.h>`. It's very ok, but in current directory layout I'm forced to change it to `<DockCtrl DEV802b.2/DockCtrl/DockCtrl.h>`.

And it makes preparing installation of upp releases much harder. Can we get back to previous layout, please?

I guess you are right. My intention was to keep the SVN/Bazaar clean. Ok, I'm moving it both to the main tree.
