Full typelessness is not so good. And absence of such fundamental type as string makes some things more different, for example, work with localization or path processing.  
Well, I prefer WString - localized identifiers will be good for applied programmers (such as in MS Excel).

IMHO, file (and other system) operations must not be accessible `_by_default_` in scripts.  
Otherwise there are `_default_` security hole - makes possible to stole or owerwrite files in such simple applications as expression calculator.

Well, your satisfaction is quite clear But IMHO, "polishing" Esc will be better than plugging in third-party scripting, such as squirrel or lua.
