It should work (I've done similar things before). If you've only got one TopSeparatorFrame:

```
...
ctrl.AddFrame(ViewFrame());
ctrl.AddFrame(TopSeparatorFrame());
ctrl.AddFrame(ViewFrame());

...
void RemoveSeparator()
{
    framepos = ctrl.FindFrame(TopSeparatorFrame());
    ctrl.RemoveFrame(framepos);
}

void AddSeparator()
{
    ctrl.InsertFrame(framepos, TopSeparatorFrame());
}
(framepos is a member variable, natch)
```

It'll be a bit more difficult if you've got more than one TopSeparatorFrame, but it should be possible with more specific information about the layout.
