Hi, I was away for a while. But now I'm back with the new version of DockCtrl.

This version has several improvements (mostly, stability issues fixed). Full serialization and custom/default layout support is added -- See ChangeLog.txt for details. Some API changes have been made. AS always, you can find the example exe in the first post of this topic. And from now on, I also upload the Source code of DockCtrl (You don't have to go the U++ SVN anymore) here too. However, you can find the nightly builds only on SVN.

You should use NOGTK keyword to compile DockCtrl correctly on KDE . Since, there was (or is?) a heap leak problem with the U++ core).

The problem seem to be fixed in the nightly builds of U++ but I Didn't have time to download it. So if you have the latest build, just remove the NOGTK keyword.

Adn one more thing: You should remove DockCtrl and DockCtrlExample folders from "DockCtrl Package" folder in order to compile them without errors.
