HTMLLayout (<http://www.terraininformatica.com/htmlayout/>) works under U++, using a DHCtrl as the base object. I think it's Windows only, though. The only issue I had is using it as a Tab. You have to manually turn on and off rendering, as the tab is selected/unselected. This is done by not calling HTMLLayoutProcND in the windows message proc. And, during the OPEN state, you have to block every message except WM_CREATE, or it will overwrite the active tab.

The only issue I had was the creation of a scroll bar that wouldn't go away, or respond to mouse clicks or moves. I even attempted to redirect mouse message to the control, but it didn't work.
