Every form control need have this settings:

1. Left border
 - A. Snap by an {control|layer} to left|right|center
 - B . Keep proportion if is snapping by an control|layer to left|right|center
2. Right border
 - A. Snap by an control|layer to left|right|center
 - B . Keep proportion if is snapping by an control|layer to left|right|center
3. Top border
 - A. Snap by an control|layer to top|bottom|center
 - B . Keep proportion if is snapping by an control|layer to top|bottom|center
4. Bottom border
 - A. Snap by an control|layer to top|bottom|center
 - B . Keep proportion if is snapping by an control|layer to top|bottom|center
