AFAIK that's a right behavior, as returned temporary string is first assigned to result and then deleted.

IMHO, the way you describe would work if the function looks like below.

```
String GetCppFile(int i);
```

Current implementation is similar to code below.

```
const String* GetCppFile(int i)
{
    INTERLOCKED_(cpp_file_mutex) {
        return &cpp_file[i];
    }
    return &String();
}
```

Does this look correct to you?
