Mindtraveller wrote on Thu, 29 May 2008 21:49 Maybe I've found a problem. After "fresh" IDE-SVN install from .deb package, if you enter Build - Output mode dialog, on the right side of it we have Link mode = Static for Release mode. But in Build methods we have Shared Libs linking for all modes (Debug & Release).

In Output mode dialog I switched Linking mode to Use shared libs, made complete rebuild and had everything linked without errors.

IIRC, output mode is stored in package config area, but build modes are global to ide. So, if you had ide installed previously and set output mode to static, it will stay there until you don't change it (or wipe .upp/theide-svn folder, which erases ALL configs, so DON'T do it ).

I don't remember if reinstalling .deb replaces .bm file, either... but I don't think so, otherwise custom settings would be lost on ide upgrade.

So, if you want to test if packages install correctly, the only choice would be to wipe .upp folder before installing OR install on a clean ubuntu.
