uhmmm... that poses some problems on debian.

Well... not the file name (I think, not tested...) but the internal version name, because of debian version ordering.

The 'Opre' added in front of latest rc1 was needed because otherwise debian package manager thinks that

2008.1-rc1 is NEWER than 2008.1

refusing so to install the release package. Adding 'Opre-' solves it because debian says that

Opre-2008.xxxxxxx is OLDER than 2008.xxxxx

because of leading 0. Nicer solutions are welcome....

OTOH, if you meant "identical in content", I agree with you, there should be just minor bugfixes between rc and finals.

But, I don't agree too much leaving RCx out of version/splash screen...
