and after then we can set parameter value;

Quote:q->SetParameter ("SomeParameter", parameter_value);

after then we can do:

Quote:QResult *q_result = q->Execute ();

QChoose q_chouse = q_result->Choose ();

while (q_chouse->Next ()) {...}

or

Quote:Array q_res = q->Execute ()->Unload ();
