and is used in

CtrlCore/Ctrl.cpp 735

I believe that putting some nice LOGs there should reveal the problem.

I'm using KDE (3.x series and 4.0.4). I did the same test under Gnome (after I installed it) and IceWm, and both of them are issue free. I think it is related to the different Gtk theme imposed by KDE. It is strange how only applications compiled by me have the issue. Thanks for the locations. I'll try to see if some logging can help to identify the problem.

Another problem under KDE is that the system tray icon is not transparent. You can see this in the SystemTray reference package.
