It's just not nice.

I think we need to add GetInsertedId(const char* sequence) to session interface. Of course one can use currval from sqlexp but I prefer getting id through session object. If I won't find any better solution I will add this new GetInsertedId version.

Does not help, MySQL does not have sequences.

Frankly, this is troublesome problem with many dead ends...
