MySql and SQLite classes would simply neglect this parameter, PostgreSQL would use parameter as a sequence name to return "SELECT currval('%s')".

This way we could create portable database software.

Well, I sort of see your argument now, but this is fundamentally broken w.r.t concurrency.

What if other client inserts a record between your INSERT and SELECT?
