The EditField style has a different colour for focus/unfocused. It was actually me that added it so that I could do exactly what I think you are trying to do (highlight the currently focused EditField).

```
This has the advantage that you can set it for every EditField in your app with one line: EditField::StyleDefault().Write().focus = Yellow();
But if you really want to only change the colour when a field has text in it then this works: void CtrlLibTest::OnEdit(EditField *ctrl)
{
    static EditField::Style s = EditField::StyleDefault();
    s.focus = Yellow();
    ctrl->SetStyle(ctrl->GetLength() ? s : EditField::StyleDefault());
}
Incidentally, you can avoid the need for a dynamic cast by setting the callback to this function with the ctrl as a parameter:
edit1 <<= THISBACK1(OnEdit, &edit1);
edit2 <<= THISBACK1(OnEdit, &edit2);
...etc
```
