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Yes, this is a (very dirty) workaround, since aptitude keeps asking if you want to upgrade.

The version available in Lenny is libstdc++6-4.3-dev. But there are also libstdc++6-4.1-dev and libstdc++6-4.2-dev, but unfortunately none have the meta-package libstdc++6-dev in Lenny.

BTW... if you run debian etch you don't need to setup a full debian Lenny to check this out. Just edit your /etc/apt/sources.list and change from etch to lenny and do apt-get update && apt-cache search libstdc++.
