Hi,

All Debian users please test `upp_2008.1_i386.deb` from Releases. I expect some feedback if there are U++ Debian users. . Ubuntu users please test this package too to see if it work on your system (it work on mine), preferably a fresh system, without upp previously installed.

Now some explanation about the package...

Logically, if we have installed `g++-4.1` it needs `libstdc++6-4.1-dev` (`g++-4.1` dependencies say that) and if `libstdc++6-dev` (no matter which version 6-*) is installed, Ultimate++ can be used to develop software. I've modified control file from *.deb package to have as dependencies `libstdc++6-4.1-dev` which however get installed with `g++-4.1` which is for moment the main compiler used by upp under Linux. If feedback is positive, we would use the same package for Debian and Ubuntu without any problem.
