Look at first example:

[n] - toolbar n'th item
: - Gap() (free space)

[0]:[1]:.....[2]

and the code to build such a toolbar

```
bar.Add(item0);  
bar.Gap();  
bar.Add(item1);  
bar.GapRight();  
bar.Add(item2);
```

All this is very intuitiv.

Now the problem. It is impossible to create the toolbar like this (using Gap() and GapRight()):

[0]:[1]:.....[2]:[3]

The code should look like:

```
bar.Add(item0);  
bar.Gap();  
bar.Add(item1);  
bar.GapRight();  
bar.Add(item2);  
bar.Gap();  
bar.Add(item3);
```

But this won't work, because Gap() does not distinguish if it is placed before or after GapRight().

To have right aligned items separated with free space I have to add empty labels or any other invisible control..

Can this be fixed?
