Just think about designing a greater-than-300-tables database without an entity-relationship diagram! The UML tool you use should allow complete forward and reverse engineering of code - that is, your diagrams should change your source and your source should change the diagrams. The higher you go design/architecture wise, the more you realize the importance of UML.
