I noticed that my foreign keys were not being created in my PostgreSQL database. So I copied a query from the Attributes script created by U++ and tried to run it manually. The query was: alter table MYTABLE1 add constraint FK_MYTABLE1\$MYT_ID foreign key (MYT_ID) references MYTABLE2.MYT_ID;

The error I received was something like:

"ERROR: schema mytable2 does not exist."

I changed the script line to:

alter table MYTABLE1 add constraint FK_MYTABLE1\$MYT_ID foreign key (MYT_ID) references MYTABLE2(MYT_ID);

Note the paren () instead of dot/period.

And it worked...

I am using PostgreSQL 8.2.9
