Well, assemblies don't just "collect" packages, but they also handle inclusion of other assemblies in build process, i.e. after default 2008.1 install at Win32 you can't work with Bazaar packages in MyApp assembly (until you add that in Edit assembly).

This also allow you to have two uppsrc (stable / SVN), and assemblies MyApp/MyAppSVN, which both refer to "Core" package, but from different assembly (version), and work on/build both in the same TheIDE.

In this sense I think the "assembly" is better name than "collection".
