What is the point, when upp is so tiny, just above a megabyte? In contrast, gtkmm alone is 3 megabytes, when you create a semi-static (shared gtk, static C++ wrapper) hello world app! And upp can do a lot more than anemic bare bones gtk to begin with.

Nah, not having to deal with hundreds of bug reports caused by subtle or not so subtle differences between dependend libraries on the various distros, is what attracted me to upp in the first place.
