for = for loop
ffor = double for loop
etc.

the coding there was:

- \$ is the placeholder for user-entries queried later (can be one or more), e.g. for var names.
- the | is where the caret will be put.
- tabs typed where shown (while the entry) as --->.

A usual key for inserting is "Ctrl + spacebar" or alike.
