I think it is a feature because you usually don't edit packages(libs) which doesn't have *_APP_MAIN unless you are the developer of that package and having such a package visible for usual users of the IDE may trick them to consider that every packages from every assembly are resulting in executables. If you browse the forum you will see there was such cases when users tried to build an executable from e.g. DockCtrl which is a "lib", so these packages should be hidden in "Select main package" and be shown just with "Add package to *". You may hide a package from "Select main package" dialog by removing its GUI flag IIRC and it will appear in "Add package to *".

I've tried your example with SysExec package and it is showed in "Add package to *" but not in "Select main package", so i think this is the right way for packages.
